Figure 1: Degrees & Certificates, Class of 2005-2009

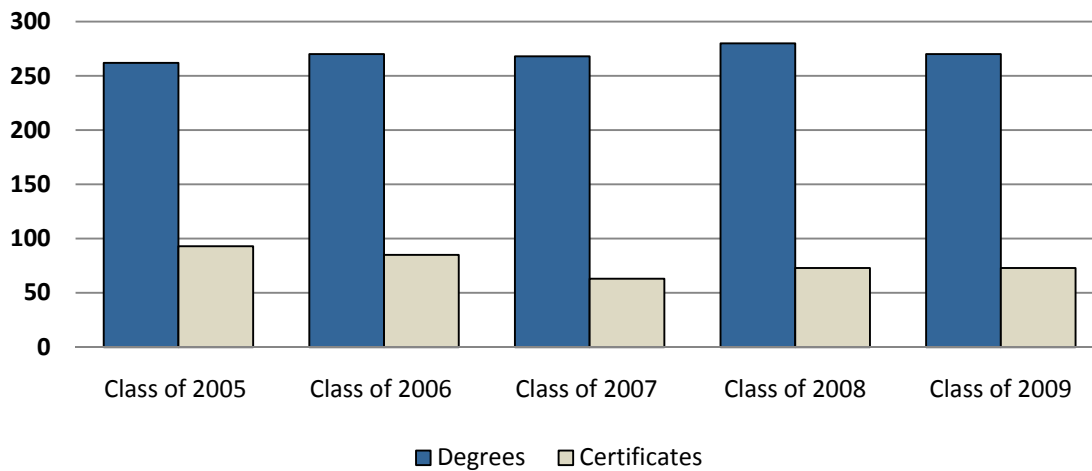
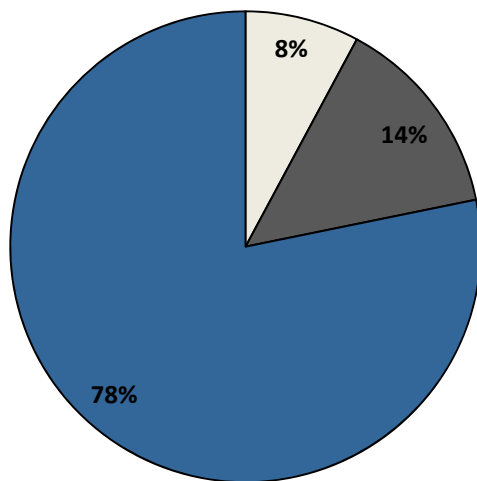

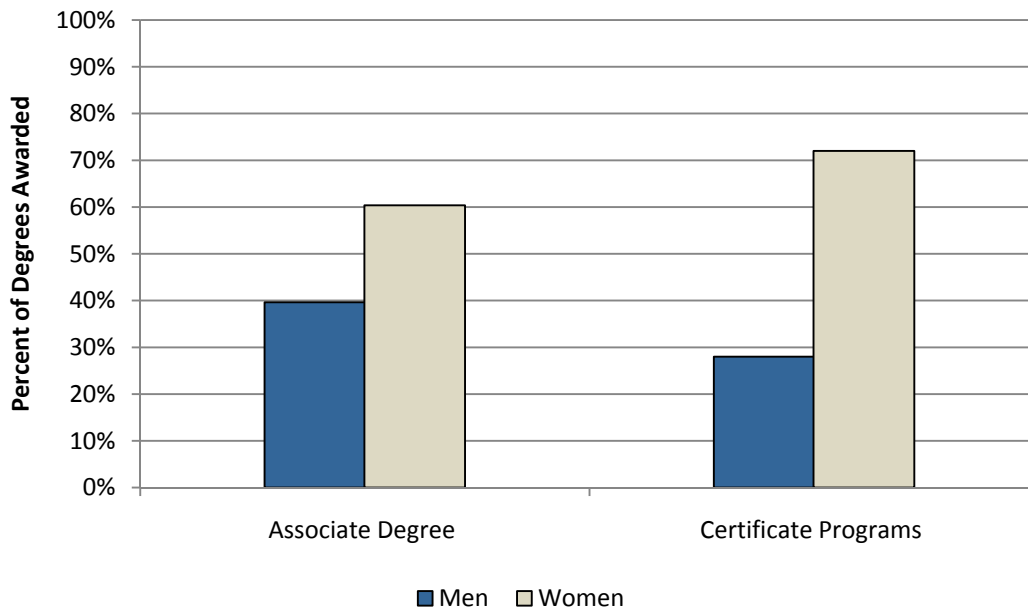

Figure 3: Gender by Award Type, Class of 2009



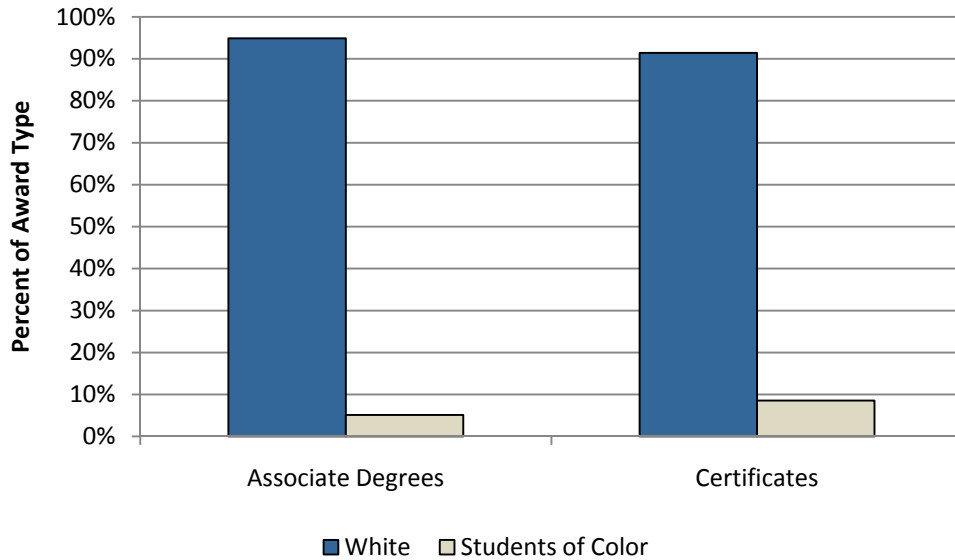

Figure 5: Time to Associate Degree, Class of 2009

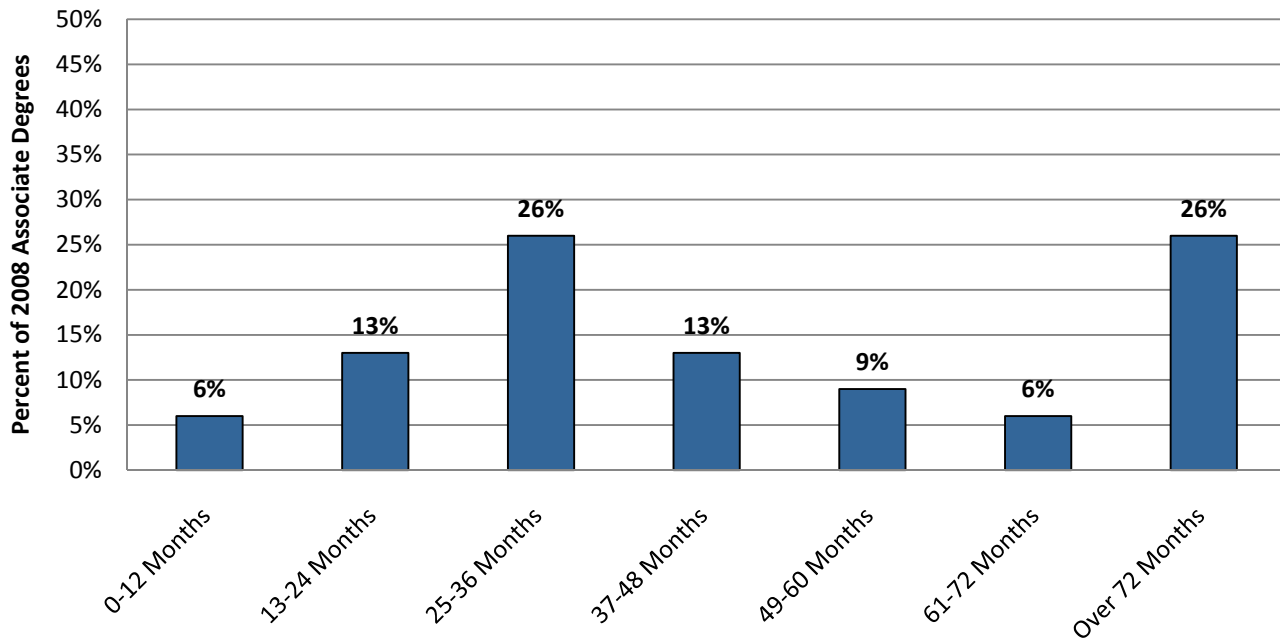
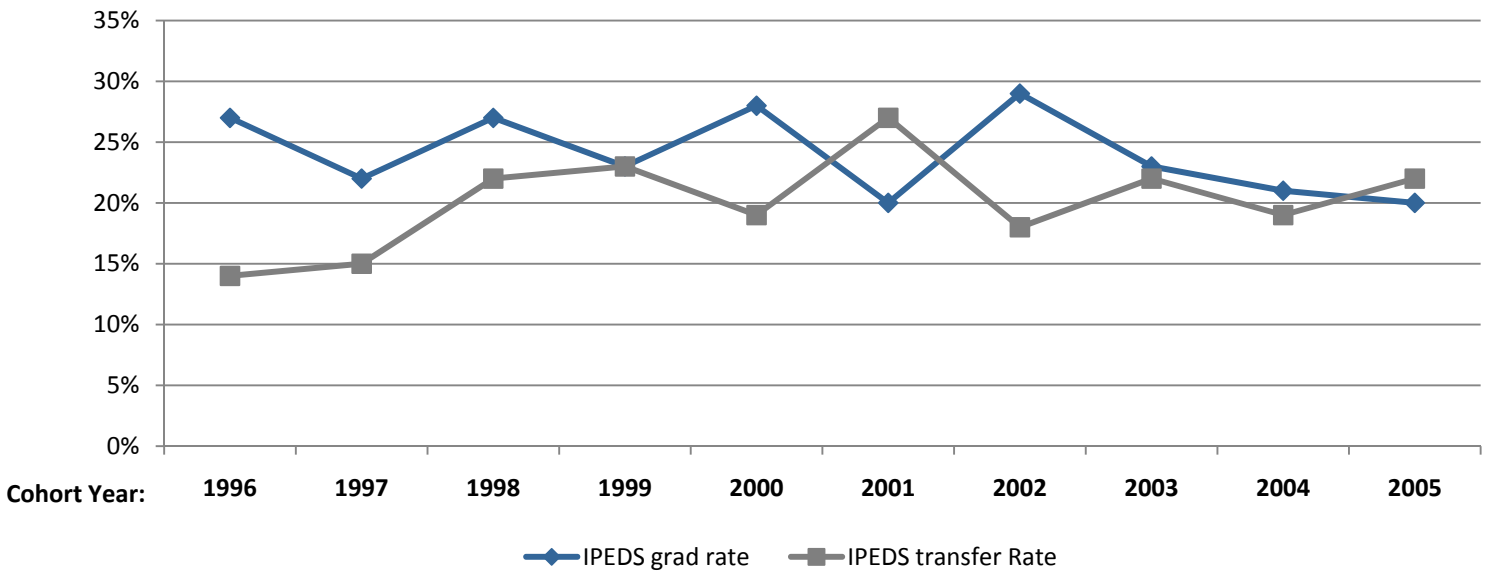
