The MassTransfer Advantage:

- 1) Advantages to getting an Associate Degree:
 - Guarantee of at least 60 credits in transfer
 - Waiver of gen eds
 - Tuition advantage - graduation with a 3.0 GPA
 - Simplified application; no fee; no personal statement paper to write; no references to provide

Where can you transfer?

To the 4 campuses of UMass - Boston, Dartmouth, Amherst and Lowell and, 7 state colleges in Massachusetts:

Fitchburg; Framingham; Westfield;
MCLA; Salem; Bridgewater; Worcester State

- 2) Learn about **special Transfer Agreements** with **private** and **selective** schools including:

Amherst College; Smith College; Mt. Holyoke College; Bay Bath College; Western New England College; American International College; Elms College; New England College; Springfield College; Unity College; Marlboro College Graduate Center-Brattleboro, Vt.

- 3) **Meet College Transfer Reps** via on campus monthly visits and the October Transfer Fair

- 4) **Help with researching 4-year schools** in the state, region, and nationally. Review degree programs, due dates and requirements for transfer

- 5) **Help with exploring the fastest growing and highest paying jobs**

- 6) **Help with finding money!** ***Scholarships***
